

American Airlines renews ICTS Europe pan-European contract

American Airlines once again renewed its contract with ICTS Europe, for another three years at all European location.

ICTS Europe extends contract with Continental Airlines

Continental Airlines has extended its contract with ICTS Europe for the provision of enhanced security, "integrated services" at the majority of its European locations.

FIS Germany is awarded contract at Cologne/Bonn Airport

FIS, the ICTS Europe subsidiary in Germany, has been awarded a Federal Ministry of the Interior contract for the provision of HBS and passenger screening at Cologne/Bonn Airport.

ICTS Ireland returning to Cork

ICTS Ireland will restart operations at Cork Airport having recently been awarded a contract with the Cork Airport AOC for provision of HBS services.

ICTS UK launches Integrated Security services for US Airways at LGW

ICTS UK launched the Integrated Security product for US Airways at London Gatwick Airport. The services provided by the ICTS Integrated Agents include among others Check-in and Security services, transfer passenger ,gate service, meet and greet arriving passengers and looking after unaccompanied minors. The service is supported by ICTS's technological platform, CPM that allows the rapid processing of the passengers.

New contracts at ICTS France

ICTS France began new security and screening operations with DHL at three new sites, Nice Airport, the Paris suburb Villeneuve-la-Garenne and Vitry-sur-Seine.

ICTS France was awarded a new contract with Air France, to operate the Transit Passengers Safety Assistance service for AF passengers arriving and departing from Paris CDG.

Projects and contracts at ICTS Albania

During the month of October, ICTS Albania, in association with MUSC Hellas, provided support for Porto Romano, Albania's oil and gas infrastructures, to ensure compliance with the International Ship and Port Security Code (ISPS).

ICTS Albania provided training services to Albanian Airlines, consisting of Airlines Security Training courses for ground and flight operations, crew and staff.

ICTS Europe's RASCargO Security Screening Product Receives Government Approval in the Netherlands

CTSN BV, ICTS Europe's Dutch subsidiary, has received approval from the Dutch Government authorities to deploy its RASCargO explosives detection screening product for the aviation cargo industry.

On September 4, at Amsterdam's Schiphol Airport, an intensive certification process took place, in which CTSN dogs and their handlers were officially certified. CTSN will now be able to launch commercial RASCargO air cargo screening services in the Netherlands.

ICTS Europe Systems, the technology arm of ICTS Europe expands its activity with new contracts.

- A new contract was signed to provide Watchlist, APIS and documentation checks solution out of the US for White Airways, a Portuguese carrier.

Dubai Airports Corporation

ACR won a contract to provide HBS support services in the new terminal at Dubai International Airport.

Ajman International Airport City

ACR was awarded an additional contract for provision of legal advice to facilitate the negotiation of the Airport Concession document. ACR has teamed with UK legal experts Pinsent Mason to deliver this contract. The Airport project team is working on the Roadmap for the airport development, leading to the 9 month detailed design phase, which is expected to start by the end of the year.

Maritime Security Update

Throughout Q3 2008, MUSC, ICTS Europe Maritime Subsidiary, continued its usual routine of maritime security training and risk analysis. In addition, a highly interesting activity performed during the quarter is described below.

MUSC provides offshore security services in Nigeria

During third quarter 2008 MUSC again demonstrated its capabilities to provide short-notice security risk analyses, backed up by on-site security services, when a major offshore oilfield contractor called for help in protecting an offshore survey in Nigerian waters.

The client had been awarded a late contract for performance of a geotechnical survey in the Oyo oil field of Nigeria's Delta coastline. The area is renowned for militant attacks on vessels and oil and gas platforms offshore, and hostages are regularly taken for ransom.

With only two days' notice, MUSC was able to deploy a maritime security team to Port Takoradi, Ghana, where the survey vessel was being mobilized. The consultant conducted a full security audit of the vessel and oversaw the necessary alterations to the ship to prevent unauthorized boarding.

Over 4 weeks, the MUSC team remained with the survey vessel, providing security advice to the vessel's Master and liaising with the oil company's security team ashore. The consultants took on the role of security watch leaders and ensured that both vessel and survey crews remained alert at all times. Daily drills and exercises were conducted to ensure the fastest possible reaction in the event of any attack.
