### The MUSC Iraq Unexploded Ordnance (UXO) survey offshore phase draws to an end!

The **MUSC UXO** survey project (offshore phase) drew to a close at the beginning of October 2009. All three survey vessels were demobilized in the UAE after 7 months of continuous and demanding work in Iraqi territorial waters. We are now looking forward to the production of the final report and presenting our findings to the client. The documentation will be the blueprint for clearing the seabed and will enable the construction of large (48-inch-diameter) oil export pipelines.

### Vessel Shield

**Vessel Shield** goes from strength to strength and the Transit Consultant team at **MUSC** safely saw over 15 vessels through the Gulf of Aden without any serious incidents. That is not to say that piracy isn't alive and well, as a number of those vessels were approached by a series of suspicious contacts, but thankfully no actual attacks were made.

### Counter-Piracy Training
