

# Aviation Security Training

ICTS works closely with the Civil Aviation Authority to ensure our certified instructors are compliant with regulations and standards, which are then incorporated into our training programmes.

## Aviation Ground Security Operative (GSO):

The GSO course is an introduction for delegates involved in basic aviation security functions, and covers the mandatory areas that all aviation ground security operatives must be trained in before they are able to work within the aviation security industry. Course content includes:

- The threat to aviation
- International and national objectives of aviation security and legislation
- Response to security incidents
- Security communications
- Access control and airport security
- Recognition of prohibited articles, firearms, explosives, incendiary devices and dangerous goods
- Using security equipment (X-Ray, Trace Detection, Metal Detection, Body Scanners)
- Searching people
- Searching baggage / items carried
- Patrolling and searching
- Searching vehicles
- Searching airport supplies
- Hold Baggage screening
- Aircraft search and protection

**Assessment by:** Written and practical tests

**Qualification:** Ground Security Operative certificate, recognised by the Department for Transport

**Duration:** Eight days (for the full course)

## Ground Security Supervisor (GSS):

The GSS course is aimed at persons directly supervising those persons implementing security controls. Course content includes:

- The role of the supervisor
- Compliance with regulations
- Response to security incidents
- Security equipment
- Searching persons and items carried
- Searching vehicles
- Searching / checking an aircraft

**Assessment by:** Written and practical tests

**Qualification:** Ground Security Supervisor certificate, recognised by the Department for Transport

**Duration:** Two Days
