

## Employee of the Year 2019: Barry Pratt

Congratulations to Barry Pratt for winning ICTS UK & Ireland's Employee of the Year 2019 Award. Barry, who is a certified paramedic and a former member of our Security team at Bristol Airport, identified and attended to an unresponsive baby whilst on duty. Barry performed CPR on the baby until the First Responders arrived on the scene. ICTS was later advised that the baby suffered from a heart condition and Barry's actions prevented what could have been a tragic outcome.



Barry joined ICTS at Bristol in June 2019 as a Security Agent. Prior to joining ICTS, Barry had a very varied career - he worked as a primary school teacher for 8 years, teaching KS1 and Reception, prior to which he worked for the Police. He acquired his medical training whilst serving in the Royal Air Force (RAF). Barry was a RAF Combat Medic during the Gulf War. Since his time with the RAF Barry has kept up his First Aid certification, recently specialising in paediatrics.

It was thanks to Barry's valuable skills and attentiveness that he managed to save the 4-week-old baby who had stopped breathing whilst at the Airport. A true super-hero and a very deserving winner of our Employee of the Year Award.
